On 21-22 October, BorderLabs CE partners met in the twin cities of Gorizia and Nova Gorica, European Capital of Culture 2025. The partner meeting reviewed achievements, upcoming study tours, and key local sites revitalized through cross-border cooperation. 
Cross-Border Work in Focus: Drent & Herent

Shaping a Shared Vision for the Three-Country Region - Regional Conference

On 25 November 2025, the BorderLabs CE project held its regional conference in Jelenia Góra, Poland, focusing on a shared vision for the Three-Country Area—Poland, Germany, and the Czech Republic. Experts and regional stakeholders discussed cross-border challenges, including demographic change, post-industrial transformation, and institutional cooperation. Workshops addressed climate adaptation, public service accessibility, energy transition, and applied science as a driver of regional development.



Pilots in focus

Mid-term reflections from BorderLabs CE

PILOT 1



The trilateral pilot has addressed stakeholder engagement challenges by aligning partner perspectives through euroregional coordination, and has laid the groundwork for a viable cross-border solution.

PILOT 2



The double-city pilot has evolved into a flexible framework combining dialogue forums with the establishment of a cross-border double-city council to support transferability.

PILOT 3



The EGTC GO pilot has highlighted the need for a legal feasibility analysis to adapt the "Albergo Diffuso" model and has been further strengthened through the b-solutions initiative.

PILOT 4



The Ister-Granum EGTC pilot has successfully captured residents' expectations for local products and has provided a strong evidence base despite limited engagement from large consumers.

PILOT 5



The Upper Austria pilot has demonstrated that addressing cross-border legal obstacles is a long-term process and has offered valuable lessons for developing effective solutions.
